

**This document is the regulations of
the III International Scientific Conference
"Agriculture of the XXI century – problems and challenges",
which will be held on 25-26-27.03.2019
in the International Conference Centre in Krzyżowa**

General provisions

§1

1. The following terms, used in these regulations, mean:

- **Organizer:** chairman of the organisational committee, together with the organisational committee.
 - **Participant:** a person making the registration by sending a form made available by the organizer.
2. The provisions of these Regulations are an integral part of the declaration of participation in the Conference and shall apply to all participants.
3. Sending an application to the Organizer is equivalent to the acceptance of these Regulations by the User and is a form of entering into obligations between the parties.

Rules of participation

§2

The prerequisite to participate in the IV International Scientific Conference “Agriculture of the XXI century – problems and challenges” is:

1. Meeting all of the following provisions:

- filling in the form in the online system available on the Organizer’s website.
- after registration through the registration form, the Organizer undertakes to confirm the registration, if there is no information concerning the registration within two working days from the registration, please contact the Organizer by mail.
- payment of the fee by 01.03.2019, to the bank account of the conference financial operator indicated by the Organizer, if the participant fails to pay the registration fee

within the specified time period, he will be automatically removed from the list of participants, the order of payments determines the participation in the conference.

- the User will be informed by e-mail about completion of all formalities.

2. The Organizer has the right not to allow the Participant to attend the Conference without giving any reason.
3. The number of Participants in the conference is limited, the order of payments is decisive regarding the participation in the Conference.
4. In case the User resigns from participation in the Conference, the organizer has the right to retain the entire registration payment.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the conference in the event of the occurrence of random events – then, all payments will be returned in full by the Organizer.

Conference

§3

1. The Conference will take place on 26-27.03.2019.
2. The researchers, PhD students, students, business representatives and people interested in the subject matter of the conference have the right to participate in the Conference.
3. The meetings are held in thematic blocks, the time of presentation of the lecture should not exceed 10 minutes, after the presentation of the papers by all Participants in the section, the time for discussion is scheduled.
4. Presentation of the poster in the A1 paper version (height 841 mm. x width 594 mm.), organizers do not allow another poster size.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to change the form of the presentation and qualification of the subject matter of the presentation in the form of a lecture or poster presentation.
6. The Organizer has the right to make changes in the schedule even on the day of the event, including the change of the order of presentations and time distribution.
7. The Organizer is not responsible for the material goods of participants which may be lost, damaged or stolen during the conference.
8. Participants shall bear full financial responsibility for the damage they have made to the premises, in which the Conference will take place.
9. The Participant is obliged to observe the safety rules including the fire protection rules, as well as the organisational and technical instructions of the Organizer and the service of the facility.

10. During the Conference, the Participant is obliged to have an ID provided by the Organizer and is obliged to present it every time at the request of the Organizer and the service of the facility.

Publication of articles

§4

1. All Participants have the opportunity to publish the papers in the form of a chapter from a scientific monograph after fulfilling the requirements published on the Conference website. The full text of the article, appropriately formatted according to the model available on the Conference website, should be sent to: contact@konferencja-rolnictwo.pl within the time limit posted on the Conference website.
2. Publication of the works in monographs will take place upon the fulfilment of editorial requirements and sending a positive review by a researcher.
3. We reserve the right to make corrections and alternations in submitted works without consulting the authors.
4. The author is obliged to timely apply any alternations and changes in the work indicated by the Organizer.
5. Failure to comply with deadlines and editorial requirements will result in the non-acceptance of the work for publication.

Final provisions

§5

1. The course of the Conference may be filmed and photographed by the Organizer and other entities with the consent of the Organizer.
2. Participation in the Conference is equivalent to the transfer of the copyrights to the Organizer regarding films and photos and expressing the consent for their commercial use by the Chairman of the Organizational Committee: it concerns the situation when the participant is filmed or photographed on the premises of the conference facilities and when the participant voluntarily agrees to give an interview or pose for photos.
3. Submission of the participant to the conference is equivalent to his consent to the processing of his personal data by the Organizer in accordance with the rules of general law, with particular regard to the Act of Protection of Personal Data of August 29, 1997 (Journal of Laws No. 133, Item 833, as amended).
4. The Organizer reserves the right to modify these Regulations.

5. All disputes concerning the organization of records shall be resolved by the Chairman of the Organizational Committee, that is the Organizer of the Conference.
6. In matters not regulated by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.
7. Any disputes that may arise out of the participation in the Conference will be settled by the court competent for the seat of the Organizer.
8. These Regulations shall enter into force on the date of its publication on the Conference website.
